Please note that I am requesting that further traffic modelling be carried out prior to the Inquiry commencing. I do not know what has already been requested, but by copy of this letter to Gareth Taylor and the generic address I am asking Camden to put this in hand forthwith. Specifically, the modelling should include the afternoon peak and be extended to include the impact of the Kings Cross Gyratory proposals.
