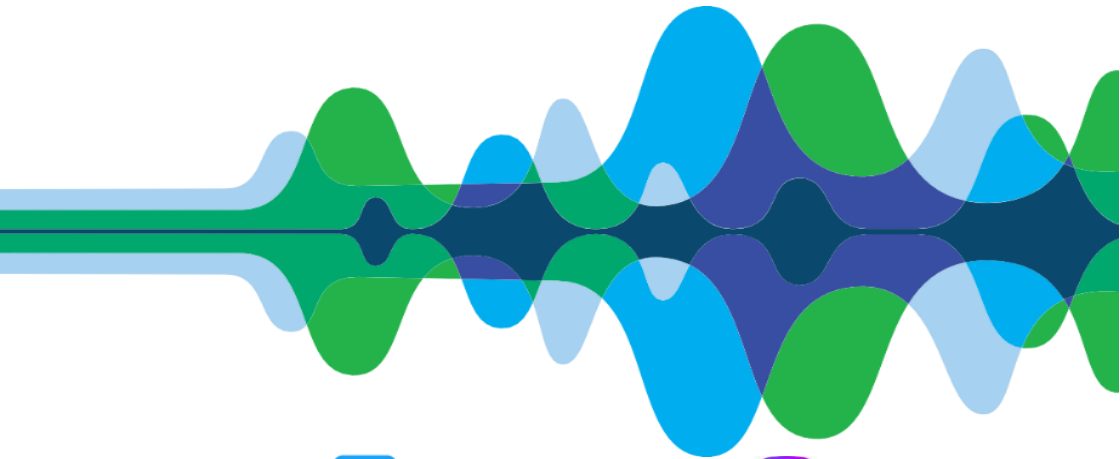




CamJam is our Junior Saturday Centre. The following groups and lessons take place at Brecknock Primary School, NW1 9AL on Saturday mornings. CamJam is in term-time only. There are ten sessions every term.

Financial help is available if your child is eligible for free school meals.

Little Jammers | 18 months to 5 years

Details: In these exciting sessions, children will develop their skills through movement, listening, singing and exploring music. They will play percussion instruments, create new music, work together to play musical games and begin to understand the elements that make up music.


Time: Different times of the morning depending on your child's age.

Next steps: Foundation

Foundation | Year 1 | Session 1 10.30 – 11.15am | Session 2 11.30am – 12.15pm

Details: In Foundation, children continue to develop their music skills. They will further develop their singing, movement to music and listening skills. They will also learn to read and write their own music using musical notation and play tuned and untuned percussion instruments. There are two Foundation sessions each morning. Children usually attend both of these.

Next steps: Singing Stars, Music Tech, Junior Soundsmiths, Cello Chickens, Recorder Rockstars, Funky Fiddles, Ukulele Unicorns, one to one instrumental lessons.



Funky Fiddles | Year 2 – 4 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: This is our beginner violin group. Children will learn to read music, improvise and play together as a group. There is a concert at the end of every term.

Next steps: CamBand, SuperStrings, one to one violin lessons

The Uke Crew | Year 2 – 4 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: This is our beginner ukulele group. The Uke Crew will learn to strum and sing along to their favourite songs. There is a concert at the end of every term.

Next steps: SuperUkes (half-term holiday course)

Singing Stars | Year 2 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Our fantastic singing group for Year 2 students! There will be singing games, new songs and termly chances to perform.

Next steps: CamJam Voices, one to one singing lessons

Cello Chickens | Year 2 – 3 | 9.45 – 10.30am

Details: This is our beginner cello group. Children will learn to read music, improvise and play together as a group. There is a concert at the end of every term.

Next steps: CamBand, SuperStrings, one to one cello lessons



Junior Cello | Year 4 – 5 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: For students who have been learning the cello for at least one term and are in Years 4 or 5.

Next steps: CamBand, SuperStrings, one to one cello lessons

Recorder Rockstars | Year 2 – 4 | 11.30am – 12.15pm

Details: An opportunity to learn the recorder as part of a small group. There is a concert at the end of each term.

Next steps: CamBand, SuperToot, Camden Youth Recorder Group, one to one lessons

Rock Band | Year 3 – 5 | 9 – 9.45am

Details: For students who are already learning the guitar, bass guitar, keyboard or drumkit. Rock Band also needs a keen singer! Places in this group are limited so please speak to us if your child would like to join.

Next steps: Holiday Course groups, Senior Rock Band

CamBand | Year 2 – 5 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Our CamJam orchestra! For students who already learn an instrument and want to share their love of music by playing with others. Woodwind, string and brass players who have been playing for at least two terms are welcome.

Next steps: Training Orchestra, Holiday Course groups



CamJam Voices | Year 3 – 5 | 11.30am – 12.15pm

Details: This is our youngest choir, with singers in Years 3 to 5. Anyone can join us!

Next steps: Camden Youth Choir, Camden Holiday Voices

Junior Soundsmiths | Year 2 – 5 | 11.30am – 12.15pm

Details: An exciting new opportunity for our young musicians to explore their own and other instruments, electronic and found sounds while working together to compose new music.

Next steps: Soundsmiths at Senior Centre, Music Tech

Music Technology | Year 2 – 5 | 10.30 – 11.15am

Details: Learn to create and compose music using computer software including Garage Band and Logic Pro. Previous projects include composing blues music and creating music to accompany an animation.

Next steps: Soundsmiths at Senior Centre, Music Tech

Adult Choir | 11.30am – 12.15pm

Details: Enjoy singing? Come and sing in a group! No experience needed. Our Adult Choir sing a range of enjoyable songs and perform regularly alongside our Youth Choirs.

Parent and Baby Ukulele | 12.30 – 1.10pm


Details: A great chance to bring along your baby while you learn to play the ukulele! With fun, singalong tunes you're sure to know, it's a great way to spend time together making music.
