

Camden Portage Home Based Learning, and Developmental Stay & Play Sessions

Portage Home Learning is an early intervention play based educational service for children under 5 years with a disability or a developmental delay in two areas.

In Portage the emphasis is always on the positive, celebrating each success & building on what your child can do.



More information about Portage

The aim of the service is to support your child's development to aid their communication, relationships and learning.

Your Practitioner will visit you in your home weekly or fortnightly planning and share activities that will help with your child's development. Portage Practitioners work in partnership with you to plan goals to support and develop your child's learning through play.

Stay & Play Sessions (term-time only)

The Camden Portage team runs developmental stay and play sessions. Just come along and drop in to one of the sessions.

These are for pre-school children who have developmental delay or who have a diagnosed or an undiagnosed disability or condition. The groups provide a variety of play based activities aimed at supporting children's learning and development.

We provide a support network for parents and share information about local services.
